OUR IMPACT

At Axis Connects and Board Ready Women, we are on a mission to advance gender equity in Calgary's business community by equipping women with the tools, resources, and networks to thrive in leadership roles. This year, we celebrated remarkable progress, driven by our alignment with the UN Women's Empowerment Principles (WEPs)—a globally recognized framework for fostering systemic change. Together with our members, partners, and supporters, we are building an inclusive, diverse workforce that recognizes and values women's contributions at every level of leadership.





Advancing Representation and Membership Growth

We are thrilled to report that Axis Connects achieved **33.5% membership growth** in 2024, welcoming **836 new members** and expanding our community to over 5,400 individuals. Board Ready Women also saw significant growth, **increasing membership by 28%**, bringing our total to **392 globally** across Canada, the U.S., and beyond. Together, we facilitate opportunities for women to move from mid-level management to senior leadership and board positions.

These milestones underscore our commitment to **UN WEP Principle 4: Promoting Education**, **Training, and Professional Development**. From skill-building workshops to networking opportunities, our programs provide women with the knowledge and support to navigate barriers and accelerate their careers. By connecting women to opportunities for growth and advancement, we create pathways to leadership that impact both individuals and organizations.

Creating Leadership Opportunities

This year, Board Ready Women promoted **331 board postings**. We connect accomplished, boardready women with meaningful opportunities, fostering inclusive corporate governance that benefits businesses and communities alike.

Since our inception, women's representation on Alberta-based boards has risen from **12% in 2018 to 27% today**, a **15% increase** that highlights the power of targeted mentorship and advocacy. Our impact on corporate boards in Alberta is undeniable. These efforts reflect **UN WEP Principle 1: Establishing High-Level Corporate Leadership for Gender Equality**, ensuring women's voices shape corporate governance and decision-making.

Driving Community and Organizational Change

Through events like the Leadership Forum, which brought together over **600 attendees** from **166 companies**, and **Career Development Dialogues**, which reached **511 participants** this year, we create spaces for bold conversations and meaningful connections. Attendees described these events as "a highlight of the year," with **85% planning to return** in 2025.

By fostering collaboration and alignment across stakeholders, we fulfill **UN WEP Principle 6: Promoting Community Initiatives and Advocacy**, advancing systemic change and championing diversity as a shared value.

Building Inclusive Workplaces and Cultures

We collaborate with organizations to develop equitable workplace policies and cultivate inclusive environments, reflecting **Principle 2: Treating All Women and Men Fairly in the Workplace.** From mentorship programs to strategic collaborations, we challenge systemic barriers and cultivate environments where everyone can thrive.

Through initiatives like the **Calgary Influential Women in Business Awards**, which recognized and celebrated **six outstanding leaders** this year, we also elevate role models and inspire change, showing what's possible when organizations prioritize diversity and inclusion.

Measuring What Matters

We believe in the power of metrics to drive accountability and progress. We regularly track key success indicators, such as board placements, membership growth, and event impact, as well as survey our membership to report on the status of gender equity in the workplace, to evaluate our progress and refine our approach.

In 2024, 29% of Leadership Forum attendees joined for the first time, demonstrating our ability to reach new audiences and expand our influence.

Our commitment to **UN WEP Principle 7: Measuring and Reporting** ensures we remain transparent and data-driven, allowing us to refine our approach and sustain progress over time.

Every initiative, program, and partnership we launch is rooted in our shared vision of a business landscape where women's contributions are valued and gender equity is the standard. We are proud to be leading this transformative work, guided by our mission to elevate women and redefine leadership for the betterment of all. Together, we are creating a legacy of inclusion and empowerment that will resonate for generations to come.
